


# CHRISTMAS WREATH ORNAMENT

# **TOOLS AND MATERIALS NEEDED**

- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- > 7 g dark green cotton yarn (50g/125 m fine (2) yarn)
- > 7 g red cotton yarn (50g/125 m fine (2) yarn )
- ~3 g silver/gold metallic yarn (20g/190 m; super fine (1))
- fibrefill stuffing

- \* I used the following type of yarn for mine:
- Schachenmayr Catania (dark green: 00430; red: 00115)
- Yarn Art Camellia (silver-411)



# **ABBREVIATIONS**

MR = magic ring

Ro = row

R = round (working in rounds)

ch = chain

slst = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

inc = increase = work more stitches into one stitch, the number and type of stitch is indicated in parentheses. e.g.:

- > inc(2sc) = work 2 single crochets into one stitch
- inc(1sc, 1hdc) = work 1 single crochet and 1 half double crochet into one stitch

tog = together/decrease = crochet together the next stitches (the number and the type of stitches indicated before 'tog'), e.g.:

- > sc2tog = the next 2 stitches are crocheted together as a single crochet
- > dc5tog = the next 5 stitches are crocheted together as a double crochet
- inv-sc2tog = the next 2 stitches are crocheted together as a single crochet with invisible decrease

FLO = front loops only

**BLO** = back loops only

#### **WREATH**



#### Materials needed:

- > 2.5 mm crochet hook
- dark green cotton yarn
- silver/gold metallic yarn

Hold together the cotton and the metallic yarn and crochet as the pattern write.

R0: Pick up 30 ch, and insert your hook in the first chain

stitch and join the last chain stitch with a slst.

Continue working in a spiral. (30)

R1: [4sc; inc(2sc)]\*6 (36)

R2: [5sc; inc(2sc)]\*6 (42)

R3: [6sc; inc(2sc)]\*6 (48) R4: [7sc; inc(2sc)]\*6 (54)

R5-8: 54sc (54)

R9: [7sc; sc2tog]\*6 (48)

R10: [6sc; sc2tog]\*6 (42)

R11: [5sc; sc2tog]\*6 (36)

R12: [4sc; sc2tog]\*6 (30)





Fasten off and leave a long yarntail for sewing. Make a wreath from the work and sew together the R0 and R12. Stuff as you sewing the wreath.

#### **BOW**

#### **Materials needed:**

- > 2.5 mm crochet hook
- red cotton yarn

#### PART 1. - Body of the bow

R1: Make 30 sc with foundation single crochet, then insert your hook in the first single crochet stitch and join the last single crochet stitch with a slst.

Continue working in a spiral. (30)

R2-6: 30sc (30)

Fasten off and weave in the yarn ends.

#### PART 2.- Tails of the bow

Ro1: Make 5 sc with foundation single crochet. (5) + 1ch

Ro2-40: 5sc (5) + 1ch

Fasten off and weave in the yarn ends.

First, fold the tail of the bow in half lengthwise, then broadwise, and then sew it together with a couple of stitches in the middle (as the picture shows). Then place it in the middle of part 1 (inside), attach it to the back inside with a couple of stitches.

#### PART 3. - Assembly

Finish the bow by looping the yarn around the middle of the 1st part so that the 1-1 tails fall to the right and left of it. When you think the center is the right size, fasten off and leave a long yarn tail for sewing. Sew the bow onto the wreath and make the hanger.
